It is an innovative addition to SAP Business One and presents manufacturers, distributors, and third-party logistics providers with greater visibility and control over inbound containers and inventory.

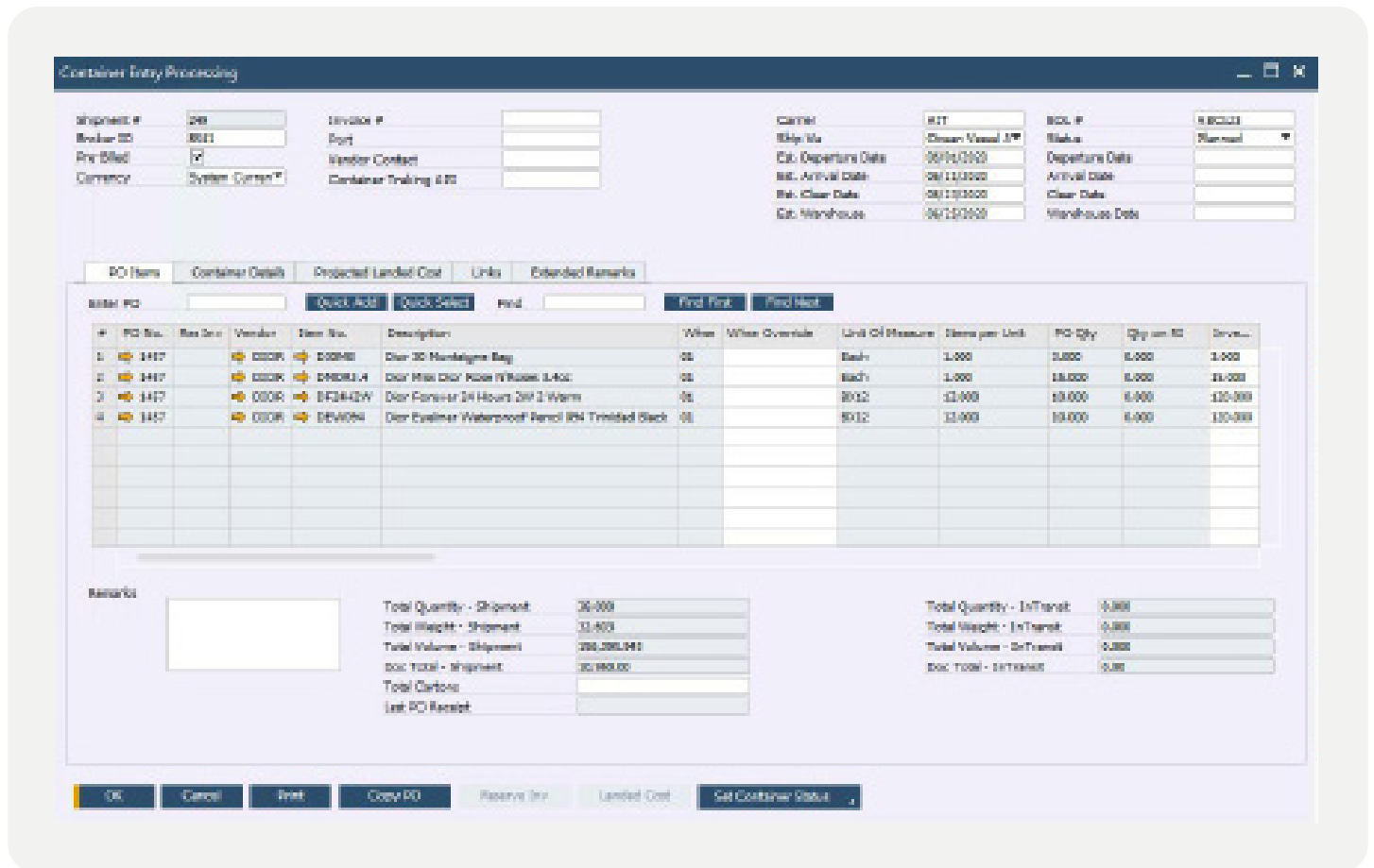
Critical container information on a single screen
